The organizing committee reserves the right to reschedule breeds according to the number of entered dogs and breeds can be moved to another day. However, all lure coursing runs per class for one breed must take place on the same day (§ 4.13.2). The team leader of every country will be informed about rescheduling at the latest 8 days after the closing date.

Veterinary control:

For dogs competing on Thursday: ► Wednesday from 13:00 hrs.

For dogs competing on Friday: ► Thursday from 11:00 hrs.

For dogs competing on Saturday: ► Friday from 11:00 hrs.

For dogs competing on Sunday: ► Saturday from 11:00 hrs.

Please note that you need to bring your dog's license book to the first veterinary control. Team leaders will get a time schedule for the veterinary control. Dogs, younger than 2 years and older than 6 years in each day must be at the veterinary control 30 minutes after the first run.

Dogs with infectious diseases are not allowed on the event area. Dogs that have been given any kind of medication or dogs with injuries are not allowed to start. Further, females in heat are not allowed to start. Any form of manipulation of the dogs, that is intended to change their natural appearance, or the performance is prohibited (§ 1.2.1).

Vet requirements:

Valid EU vaccination passport or pet passport where the dog's identification marking as well as the expiry date of vaccinations is recorded. The vaccination passport must be presented at each veterinary control. The vaccination regulations approved by the Polish General Veterinary Inspectorate are followed in the events.

In order to attend an event, a dog must have the following valid vaccinations:

vaccination against rabies (21 days withdrawal period)

Regulations for import

<u>Please note!</u> Deworming

Information for owners who return to their home country where deworming is required before returning. Our veterinarian can deworm for a cost of 5 €/dog. Please, bring your own tablets, they are not available from our veterinarian.

Identifications:

The dog must have a readable microchip or readable tattoo.

Coursing distances:

For Whippets, Italian Sighthounds and Cirneco dell'Etna: 600 - 800 meters. For all other sighthound breeds: 800 - 1000 meters.

Small variations of the above distances are tolerated (§ 4.9.2).

Terrain and ground:

Free fields on a natural slightly sloping meadow with grass.

Type of lure:

Lure pulled over pulleys.

Doping:

All kinds of doping are forbidden (§ 1.2.1, § 1.9), doping tests will be implemented. When a dog owner enters a dog to an event, the owner also agrees that the dog may be tested for doping. The dog's owner is bound to make his dog available for doping test. The event will observe the antidoping regulations approved by the Polish Kennel Club council and FCI regulations (§ 1.9).

Responsibility disclaimer:

Neither the organizer, nor the officials are responsible for injuries incurred by the dog owners, the dogs, or the officials. Likewise, they accept no responsibility in case of escaped dogs. The owner of a dog is not responsible if his dog injures another dog during a run or course. In all other cases the dog owner has the full responsibility for the dog (§ 1.10).

Admission:

FCI-CACIL class, FCI-Open class, FCI regulations § 1.4, § 4.2, § 4.3, § 4.5, § 4.6, § 4.8

- Dogs can participate in the FCI-CACIL class or FCI-Open class in accordance with their valid licences, classes cannot be mixed.
- Maximum 6 dogs per country per breed and gender in total.
- Both classes can only be separated by sex if there are 4 or more males and 4 or more females participating (4 + 4).
- A dog can only be entered in one class in accordance with his valid licence.
- To be entered any sighthound must have completed the last two lure coursing events (national or international) before the deadline of the entry without disqualification. Solo runs cannot be taken into account.
- A disqualification between the entry closing date and the date of the championship precludes participation.
- Qualification runs completed before the age limit set forth in § 1.4 is reached are invalid.
- The FCI World Champion Lure Coursing 2023 and CSS World Lure Coursing Winner 2023 can defend their titles in the class of their current license (FCI-Open class or FCI-CACIL class) and can be entered in addition to the maximum permissible participants.
- Studbook required according to FCI regulations § 4.5.1.

Entry closing date:

The entry closing date is April 8th, 2024, end of the day.

Entries:

Entries can only be done by the dog owner's national canine organization. Entries can only be sent in via the official Excel file, which is sent in advance, attached with this invitation.

Payment:

The entry fees must be paid to the organizer by the due date to bank account (§ 4.11). Payment must be made by the national organization within 7 days after the entry closing date (due date: April 15th, 2024).

FCI-CACIL allocation:

FCI-CACIL will be awarded according to the FCI regulations § 5. When the National Organization on the registration form indicates that the dog has got a FCI-CACIL class license and applies for the FCI-CACIL, this is accepted as evidence.

National certificates:

National certificates (CCWC) will be awarded per breed/class/gender. The minimum number of participants must be 4 per breed/class/gender.

Prizes:

If there are 2 dogs or more of one breed a FCI world championship CACIL class and Open class title can be awarded within the breed's class. If there are 2 or more males and 2 or more females of one breed a FCI world championship CACIL class and Open class title per gender (2 in total per class) is awarded within the breed. If there is a solo run for the breed the dog can be awarded with an official title if it has achieved at least 85 % of the maximum points (§ 4.8).

Prizes of honor for the first six ranked dogs. Special prize will be awarded for Best In Field each day. Each participant receives a souvenir for memory.

Catalogue:

The catalogue can be purchased on site. Pre-order papier version of catalogue will be possible order by organizer website till April 22nd, 2024. A limited number of catalogues will be for sale at the event.

Other information:

- In the start we say GO and give you a tap on the back.
- The use of a muzzle is compulsory for all breeds.
- Red and white jackets are compulsory; text, signs or other attributes that can be used to identify the dog are not allowed on the jackets.
- For dogs not competing and need help from our vets a cost of 25 € (+ cost for medicine) will be payed of the owner in cash on site.
- Dogs must be kept on leash at all times. Please clean up after your dogs! Violation of these rules will result in a penalty of 60 €.
- First aid resources will be available on spot.
- In case of an eventual cancellation of the event, beyond the organizer's responsibility, no liability will be taken.

Camping:

Book online on our website www.wcc2024.pl at the latest April 8th, 2024. If no reservation is made, there is no guarantee for a camping lot.

Camping is open from Tuesday May 21st, 2024 from 9:00 CET until Monday May 27th, 2024.

The caravan or car with tent fee from Tuesday until Monday is 45 €/place.

As every year, the campsite will be divided in different country areas, which will be determined depending on the number of participants from the different countries. Area for campers, caravans and tents is provided. Without a booking availability is not guaranteed. Sanitation (toilets, water supply) is available. Electricity is not provided.

All camping facilities will be provided by Zielona Brama, Przywidz.
